From the Gospel of John Series: 7 Signs that Lead to Life **Our Text for the Week of 3.21 is John 9.**

In this series, we trace seven key miracles witnessed by the apostle John that are meant to lead us into a closer relationship with Jesus. John selected these miracles and called them “signs,” because Jesus performed them for a reason beyond the sake of the miracles themselves. Each miracle points to Jesus in a powerful and unique way. We continue with the miracle where opened the eyes of a man who had been born blind. Read John 9:1–7.

4. If this kind of healing happened today, would anyone notice?
5. Do you ever question why some people are born with physical limitations?
6. Why did the disciples initially seem more interested in his sin than his healing?
7. Describe a time when Jesus spiritually opened your eyes to a situation.
8. Is God working in your life in a way that others can notice and observe?
