Our Text for the Week of 9.5: 2 Kings 3:9-20

What does it mean to be spiritually thirsty? We all know what it is like to experience physical thirst, but it is much harder to recognize spiritual thirst. It is often something that even churches struggle to discern until the point of extreme spiritual dryness. May our thirst lead us to the one who can refresh us by His Word and Spirit. Read 2 Kings 3:9–20.

6. Why do activities become a substitute for the presence of God?
7. What does God want you to do to be ready and refreshed?
8. What does it look like to live by the Spirit of God?
