Fulfilled in Christ – How the BIG Jewish Festivals Point to Jesus Part One: “Tabernacles Fulfilled”

As we step into the Christmas season, we take a moment to explore the three BIG Jewish celebrations that are highlighted in the Old Testament. Jesus said that there was much in the Old Testament that had to be fulfilled through Him. In this mini-series, we consider how the Festivals of Tabernacles, Pentecost, and Passover point to Him and are still being fulfilled by Him. Read Leviticus 23:33–44

With Tabernacles, there is an ongoing celebration:

That God is a God who Provides
That God is a God who Forgives
That God is a God who Incarnates
That God is a God who Restores

Questions for Group Discussion:

2. What is your favorite celebration and why?
3. How do Tabernacles point to a God who provides?
4. Describe a time when God supernaturally provided for you.
5. How do Tabernacles point to a God who forgives and restores?
6. How do Tabernacles point to a God who is with us?
7. How can we make the most of our earthly tabernacles now?
