## **Fulfilled in Christ – How the BIG Jewish Festivals Point to Jesus Part Three: “Passover Fulfilled” Luke 22:7-23**

As we step into the Christmas season, we take a moment to explore the three BIG Jewish celebrations that are highlighted in the Old Testament. Jesus said that there was much in the Old Testament that had to be fulfilled through Him. In this mini-series, we consider how the Festivals of Tabernacles, Pentecost, and Passover point to Him and are still being fulfilled by Him. Read Luke 22:7–23.

### **As Jesus was celebrating Passover with His disciples, we see:**

The removal of the leaven points to our sin upon Him

The dressing of the white linen points to our righteousness from Him

The lighting of the candles points to the light that comes from Him

The eating of the bitter herbs points to the suffering by Him

The eating of the lamb points to the perfect sacrifice by Him

The revealing of the bread points to the resurrection by Him

The drinking from the final cup points to the true identity of Him

### **Questions for Group Discussion:**

1. What would you say are the three biggest celebrations in our culture today?
2. Describe what you enjoy the most about those celebrations.
3. From Exodus 12, what was the original meaning of Passover?
4. How does the Passover lamb point to Jesus?
5. Have you ever sacrificed something for the sake of Christ?
6. Describe a time when you felt rescued by God.
7. How would you react if you were sitting at the table when Jesus revealed his betrayal?

### **Final Thoughts and Closing Prayer:**

How should being at the Lord’s table impact my attitude and actions?

How will I live differently this week because of this study?
