The Gospel of the Next Day **Special Christmas Message, 12.26** **Galatians 1:1-10**

Christmas day may be over, but does the good news about Jesus ever become old news? Sometimes we lose sight of the gospel and the importance of living by it every day. This message will challenge us to remember what the gospel is and why we should never get over it. Read Galatians 1:1-10

With the goal of refocusing on the gospel, we ask the following questions:

The Gospel has been given to us from God

The Gospel is the power of God's forgiveness and God's presence

The Gospel is our only hope of being restored to God

Questions for Group Discussion:

1. What are your favorite traditions that we have in church?
2. What were the traditions that prompted Paul to write Galatians 1?
3. Why is it sometimes difficult to distinguish traditions from the gospel?
4. What is the danger in confusing traditions with the gospel?
5. Describe the power of the gospel and why the gospel is so important
6. Would you say that your life is more based on traditions or the gospel? Why?
7. Where do you turn with the hope of receiving God's forgiveness?
8. Where do you turn with the hope of improving your life and pleasing God?

What will I do to experience the gospel every day of my life?

How will I live differently this week because of this study?
