Fulfilled in Christ – How the BIG Jewish Festivals Point to Jesus Part Two: “Pentecost Fulfilled” Leviticus 23:15–22

As we step into the Christmas season, we take a moment to explore the three BIG Jewish celebrations that are highlighted in the Old Testament. Jesus said that there was much in the Old Testament that had to be fulfilled through Him. In this mini-series, we consider how the Festivals of Tabernacles, Pentecost, and Passover point to Him and are still being fulfilled by Him. Read Leviticus 23:15–22.

With Pentecost, there is an important reminder that:

God’s Plan is Greater than Ours
God’s Profit is Greater than Ours
God’s Power is Greater than Ours

Questions for Group Discussion:

1. What would you say are the three biggest celebrations in our culture today?
2. Describe what you enjoy the most about those celebrations.
3. What does Pentecost teach us about waiting and depending on God?
4. Describe a time when God’s plan led you in a different direction.
5. Why do we have a difficult time trusting God with our finances?
6. Have you ever waited on God for a particular need in your life?
7. What about your life needs to change so that you are depending on God?

Final Thoughts and Closing Prayer:

How will I spend more time in prayer this week to wait upon God?
How will I live differently and experience more of Him because of this study?
