“Faith to Ask the Right Questions”

Our Text for the Week of 8.8: 1 Samuel 14:1–23

Who is the real King of your heart? We continue answering that question in part twelve where Saul’s oldest son and his sidekick slip away from the Israelite army with the goal of storming the nearby Philistine garrison. What questions were they asking and NOT asking when it came to making that decision?

Read 1 Samuel 14:1–23.

Being in a position to allow God to work through you means:

Having faith to believe that God is at work

Having faith to behold that God is at work

Having faith to become a partner with God in that work

Questions for Group Discussion:

1. What questions would you have been asking in Jonathan’s position?
2. Have you ever done something on your own that turned out okay (or not)?
3. Describe a time when you felt outnumbered or that the odds were against you.
4. Have you ever wondered what God would like to do through you?
5. What signs should you be looking for and how will you recognize them?
6. In what areas do you currently see God at work?
7. What role does faith play in your daily decision-making?
8. What are the things that hold you back from partnering with God?

How will I pray and live differently because of this study?
