The Power of The Word: Luke 4:14-30



Luke 4:14-44 In verses 18-19, Jesus reads Isaiah 61:1,2. Who are the poor, the brokenhearted, the captive, the blind and the oppressed today around us?

Is God calling you to reach out to any of these today?

Read Luke 4:17-20. What did Jesus do when He was handed the scroll of the prophet Isaiah?

In verses 23-27, Jesus relates the people of His hometown to those who rejected Elijah and Elisha. Why were they so offended at what He said? Who would Jesus relate the church to today and why? What verses would He read to the Church today? How about to you?

How can I start showing people they need Jesus versus just telling them they need Him? Ideas you have?

Don't rush by His statement, "**Today this scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing.**"

What does that statement mean to you today?

Do you call Him, Lord, Liar or Lunatic? Does your actions show He is your first love?

Final Thoughts This Week on this Passage: If all five areas of Jesus' mission are to be carried out by the church as a whole, which area of concern do you give priority AND which do you neglect? outreach (evangelism), worship, fellowship, discipleship and service. In 2023 what will you do to rearrange your calendar to match Jesus' mission?
